In response to your request for comments re the above level crossing I would like to say that I object to any changes.

Whilst the risk assessment suggests that improvements should be made there are no reported cases of near miss at this site, [at least not recorded on the associated website]. The length of time the double barrier is closed at Shepreth station can be very long [ditto Foxton level crossing]. On the minor road from Shepreth to Meldreth the barrier is closed for a much shorter time. The locals know that the barrier won't be closed for too long so respect the red flashing lights & don't take chances like those that are occasionally seen & reported at Shepreth Station & Foxton station.

Save the money & put it to better use.
