Subject: Network Rail (London to Corby) (Land Acquisition, Level Crossing and Bridge Works) Order

Dear Sir/Madam

I OBJECT to the Order being conferred to rebuild the Bromham Road Bedford rail bridge for two reasons:

1. There is no provision of a 3 metre or wider dual use cycle/pedestrian path on the north side of the bridge.
2. High levels of disruption to the residents of Bedford. The TWAO has no timescales, but I believe that there is likely to be no road access whatsoever for at least 7 months (assuming you hit timescales, which I suspect you won't). A solution based around craning in a pre-built structure(s) should have been considered, to minimise the disruption to Bedford.

I look forward to hearing a response. I do expect a response, not just an acknowledgement.
