Subject: Objection to Rother Valley Railway extension at Robertsbridge

Dear Sir

I write to object to the extension of the Rother Valley Railway at Robertsbridge, and in particular to the compulsory purchase orders under the Transport and Works Act.

My main grounds for objection are:

1. It is wrong in principle for compulsory purchase orders to be used for what is basically a private hobby railway.
2. Taking the land for a railway would be significantly environmentally damaging.
3. The development would attract significant road visitors but the proposal contains no provisions for car parking.

I believe that the issues are such that a Public Inquiry should be held.
