I would like to object to Rother Valley Railway applying for a Transport and Works Act which incorporates a Compulsory Purchase Order (CPO) to have a railway line from Robertsbridge to Bodiam.

The detrimental impact to traffic, flora and fauna, flood planes and Robertsbridge is well documented and I agree with it all however the issue that concerns me the most is the fact that the existing line between Bodiam and Tenterden is being upgraded to take far heavier engines (believed to be up to 21 ton/axle) than it was originally designed for and one of the benefactors owns a company that has a TOC providing a license to run trains anywhere across the country on Network Rail.
