- > I would like to register my concerns over the development of the Robertsbridge Steam Railway extension and what is a very disturbing development in the use of the Compulsory Purchase system. My understanding is that it was introduced to allow the development of essential infrastructure that would benefit the community in general.
- > I have no opinion on railways one way or the other but I do have some serious reservations about what would appear to be a manipulation of a system designed to benefit communities at the behest of a specific interest group backed by considerable private wealth.
- > I am left wondering what power the local government has if wealthy individuals are able to manipulate the system with such apparent ease. Are we allowing a precedent to be set where a company wishing to develop a theme park could use the same argument in order to purchase land?
