Please accept this email as a strong opposal to the plans to install a new level crossing on the A21.

( <a href="http://www.rvr.org.uk/Planning%20Applications/A21%20delays%20Exec%20Summary.pdf">http://www.rvr.org.uk/Planning%20Applications/A21%20delays%20Exec%20Summary.pdf</a> ) states that the Closures per hour and Average closure time will be less than that of the now removed Beddingham crossing but in doing so it also acknowledges that it *will* add a delay.
Adding delays, no matter how small to an already slow road is completely contrary to all the work being done to improve access to the A21 (Hastings ridge junction) and the dualling of other sections of the A21.
