I wish to register my strong objections to the proposed level crossing on the A21 south of Robertsbridge. This major road, already cited as the most dangerous in the country, has long been neglected for improvement by central government. Failure to forward plan when neglecting to provide an exit from the M26 to the A21 has blighted many villages as heavy traffic struggles to make the west east journey from Dover. The decision for dualling of the A21 from Tonbridge to Tunbridge Wells, recently completed, was delayed for so long costs were eventually hugely inflated.

Any minor delays on the long single carriageway sections, like a parked vehicle, breakdown, stopping refuse lorry etc cause huge backlogs.
