Dear Sir or madam.

I understand that an application has been made by the Rother Valley Railway to re-instate, by way of a level crossing, the old railway line between Bodiam & Robertsbridge.

I would wish to oppose such a crossing. The A21 is the only route from the M25 to Hastings, St Leonards, Bexhill and Rye and traffic especially at weekends & in summer is very heavy indeed. Closure of level crossing gates always leads to delays and I had believed that to add further congestion to the road would be contrary to good transport management. Congestion on the A21 is bad enough anyway please do not make it worse by agreeing to the level crossing.
