I am writing to voice my concern and objection to the proposed new crossing over the A21 by Rother Valley Railway. As a frequent user of the A21 at all times of the day, I am aware of the high volume of traffic and the extremely long queues which form at any point where the traffic flow is reduced. This has a massive impact on my working day as I am a community healthcare professional therefore any delays to my journey have the potential to negatively impact patient care.

I understand the need for crossings for essential reasons i.e. Safe pedestrian crossing or traffic junctions. I do, however, object to the proposal of causing huge traffic disruption for a non essential cause which this railway crossing is. I appreciate that steam railways are an important part of our heritage however as we already have an extensive steam railway line in Rother Valley, I feel that the planned extension is non essential and entirely unnecessary.
