On hearing about the new proposed railway crossings planned across the A21, I feel compelled to write to express our strong disagreement and opposition to these plans.

We live at the top of [redacted], our son goes to [redacted] both my husband and I work in [redacted] and we have family living in [redacted]. We use the A21 heavily. The traffic on our daily journeys along the A21 are often held up with traffic through commuter volume, slow moving vehicles (lorries, refuse vehicles and farm machinery), roadworks and accidents as it is. The addition of a rail crossing, which from looking at the plans and reasons seem to offer no real benefit or value to the community compared to its drawbacks, would create a huge disruption to daily life as well as additional pollution and hazards.

We strongly oppose these plans and urge you to reconsider this decision.
