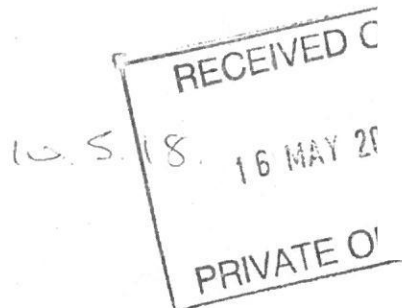

Dear Mr. Grayling,

This letter is confirmation that
I OBJECT to the proposed RVR.
It will adversely affect highway
safety.

Having a level crossing on the A21
will be a complete nightmare. I
counted traffic on ~~the~~ Bank Holiday
Monday - there were approximately
900 cars per hour going south
& a similar number going north
(this was mid afternoon). This
weekend on Monday also had
50,000 motor bikes down A21.

When people have been held
up - they tend to accelerate

afterwards; this make the southern
entrance to Robertbridge very vulnerable.
Already there have been many serious
accidents.

A railway line across the water
meadows will alter the flood plain
& make Robertbridge more
vulnerable to floods; in spite
of flood barriers which will be required.

I think that a tourist attraction
should not take precedence over
people's livelihoods (ie the farmers).
Compulsory purchase is appalling.

It has been suggested by
the government that A21 should be
direct carriage way to Haslemere
to increase accessibility & encourage
new business. RVR does the
complete opposite
