> We are strongly in favour of extending the railway along the old track bed from Bodiam Castle to Robertsbridge station.

> We visit relatives, who live close to the castle, twice a year. We have to drive from North London along miserable narrow roads. It is a journey I dread driving because of the traffic in the London suburbs & the last lap. Being able to go by train with a change at Robertsbridge will be wonderful. My relatives were told by a farmer they know that the steam train to Bodiam will be very slow. I believe they only travel at 30 mph. But the time difference between 20 & 45 mph is trivial over a couple of miles. It does not worry us. Roll on the railway. I have mentioned it to others & they say they will use the line, if you allow it, to visit Bodiam Castle. They would not consider going by road because of the poor roads. From the map Bodiam station is only a 5 min stroll to & from the Castle. Please allow the line to happen.
