Extracts from Suffolk County Council planning permission PL\01 88\15 (MS/2432/15)

DESCRIPTION OF DEVELOPMENT

Variation of condition 1 (time limit) of planning consent MS/1446/04 to allow the continuation of the extraction of sand and gravel and importation of inert waste for restoration to meadows and reed beds (until 31 December 2020 for extraction and 31 December 2022 for restoration)

Gallows Hill Quarry, Barking, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP6 0PF

*1 Mineral extraction shall cease by 31 December 2020 **and the site shall be restored by 31 December 2022 in accordance with the relevant conditions below, unless otherwise approved by the Mineral Planning Authority.***

Footpaths

*51 Permissive footpaths shall be provided in the locations identified on drawing **GH19B**, to a minimum width of 1.5 metres and with a surface comprising compacted aggregate to a depth of 200mm:*

- a) in respect of the area south of Public Footpath 33, within 3 months of the completion of final restoration levels in that area;*
- b) b) in respect of the area north of Footpath 33 within 3 months of the formation of final restoration levels in that area.*

Reason To ensure the timely provision of approved permissive footpaths in accordance with the NPPF and its Technical Guidance
