Network Rail (Suffolk Level Crossing Reduction) Order



I have reviewed OBJ/53 Taylor Wimpey's (TW) proof of evidence submitted in support of the objection made to the proposals for S29 Hawk End Lane. I have the following comments on the evidence as presented:

- 1. In Taylor Wimpey's proof of evidence at paragraph 3.1, Andrew Wright states that "TW received no formal notice of the Network Rail (Suffolk Level Crossing Reduction Order) [sic] ('the draft order') as it was not properly served."
- 2. I confirm that 3 notices, Notice 186 (temporary use of Plot No. 11), Notice 189 (temporary use of Plot No. 12), and Notice 191 (acquisition of rights over Plot No. 13) were served on Taylor Wimpey UK Ltd on 24 March 2017. A copy of these notices is attached to this rebuttal.
- 3. Each notice not only sets out the rights or powers sought over each plot of land owned by TW, but also the overall purpose of the Order that NR is seeking powers to close or downgrade a number of level crossings, all of which are listed in the notice.
- 4. These notices were addressed to the Company Secretary, Taylor Wimpey UK Limited, Gate House, Turnpike Road, High Wycombe, HP12 3NR. Gate House, Turnpike Road, High Wycombe is the registered office of both Taylor Wimpey UK Ltd and Taylor Wimpey Plc.
- 5. Network Rail sent the notices using the Royal Mail Signed For service. I asked a colleague in Bruton Knowles to check with Royal Mail whether these items were in fact delivered, and Royal Mail for each notice confirmed that Royal Mail "delivered this item on 24/03/07", and that in all three cases the item was signed for on delivery.
- 6. Therefore, I can confirm that the notices were correctly served on TW, in accordance with the requirements of the Transport and Works (Applications and Objections Procedure) Rules 2006.

- In the District of Babergh, Parish of Brantham: Works Nos. 5, 6 and 7 (footbridges carrying paths over a drain/watercourse).

The Order also confers powers for the construction and maintenance of works, including the creation of new rights of way; provides for compensation to be paid for any person who suffers loss as a result of the extinguishment of a private right of way; applies the compensation provisions of the Highways Act 1980 to the creation of new rights of way; permits Network Rail to acquire land and interests in land, including the temporary use of land, in connection with the construction of the scheduled and authorised works; authorises the temporary stopping up of streets; works in streets, traffic signs; and related purposes.

The draft Order provides for-

• the compulsory purchase of rights in the land described in schedule 1 below, in which it is believed you have an interest.

The Secretary of State has determined that the application is not to be made subject to an environmental impact assessment.

The application contains a statement that a direction for deemed planning permission is being applied for.
