We agree that it is right to downgrade this crossing as proposed by Network Rail, but we think that the plans that have been given out are a bit excessive and unnecessary. And we feel it could lead to further problems in the future.

Our worries are.

- Increased risk of Rubbish & fly-Tipping
- Gathering area for people which could cause noise & Anti-social Problems.
- Environmental Issues - vermin & Blocking field Drains.

We would just like abit more common sense put to this issue. We agree that closing the Crossing to traffic is sensible and needs to be done but do think the plans are excessive and as there has never been any issues to date.

We have only just found out about

this plan when we saw Notice on the gate two weeks ago, we did know that the crossing was going to be closed but not the rest of the Plan.

After talking to the farmers that use the gate, that was the first we knew of what was planned. We never recieved any letter or notice that this was the final proposed Plan.
