## Network Rail Cambridgeshire Level Crossing Reduction Order

I am writing as I would like to object to the above Transport and Works Act Order (TWAO) proposed works at location C08 Ely North Junction.

The proposed diversion of the existing public right of way at location C08 concerns me as I believe it will cause significant harm to my property. I would like to **object** as there will be significant harm due to the increased risk to the security of my property and the resultant blight this will bring.

Risk of Burglary - Over the past few years there have been a number of burglaries in Queen Adelaide, one recently on the same side of the Ely Road (South) as my house which also has access to the meadow that is proposed to be used as the new route for the right of way. I am concerned that this proposed diversion of the right of way will make available a new way to access to my house. This access will not be overlooked and so will raise the risk of burglary to my and adjacent properties. As a result I would like to raise an **objection** to the significant harm to my property and its occupants caused by the increased risk of burglary.

Blight - Currently there is no public access to the land adjacent to the South of my property. The proposed diversion of the public right of way will permit easy access to this land, and I believe this will lead to my property being affected. As a result I believe there will be blight to my property leading to a negative impact to the value of my property. I would like to raise an **objection** based on the significant harm to my property caused by blight..
