## Dear Joanna.

Thank you for your time on the phone this morning.

As discussed Burges Salmon act for South Yorkshire Pension Authority who own land at Cross Drain Farm served by the public highway Black Horse Drove which crosses the network rail assets at C28. The Authority had not objected to the level crossing order as they had understood that the highway to the boundary of their land would remain public despite the change in the rights over the level crossing. They have received a letter from Cambridgeshire County Council advising that this is not the case and that the public highway between the level crossing and their property would be stopped up. This has naturally caused some concern and our client is now considering their position and whether they need to become involved in this process.

As you have advised that there will be discussions on the C28 crossing we would be very grateful if you could let us know of the programming for that and any relevant public submission made by Network Rail on this.

Although we are not registered as an objector at this time our clients are considering making a late representation for consideration by the Inspector due to the change in the proposal for the access and I expect to be in touch regarding that in short course.
