I am making representation on behalf of W, C, T Aldous owners of the Pannington Hall Estate writing to you with regard to The Network Rail (Suffolk Level Crossing Reduction) Order SO5 - Pannington Hall level crossing. We have indicated on the plan attached, points A-B, we do not consider this section of the footpath is required, as there is also the proposed footpath on the south side of the road. We have marked with a X, a sensible place that walkers could cross the road from the footpath running south of the road and connecting up to the footpath that would then cross over the bridge at C. We would ask that you reconsider this.

Please do also confirm receipt of this email

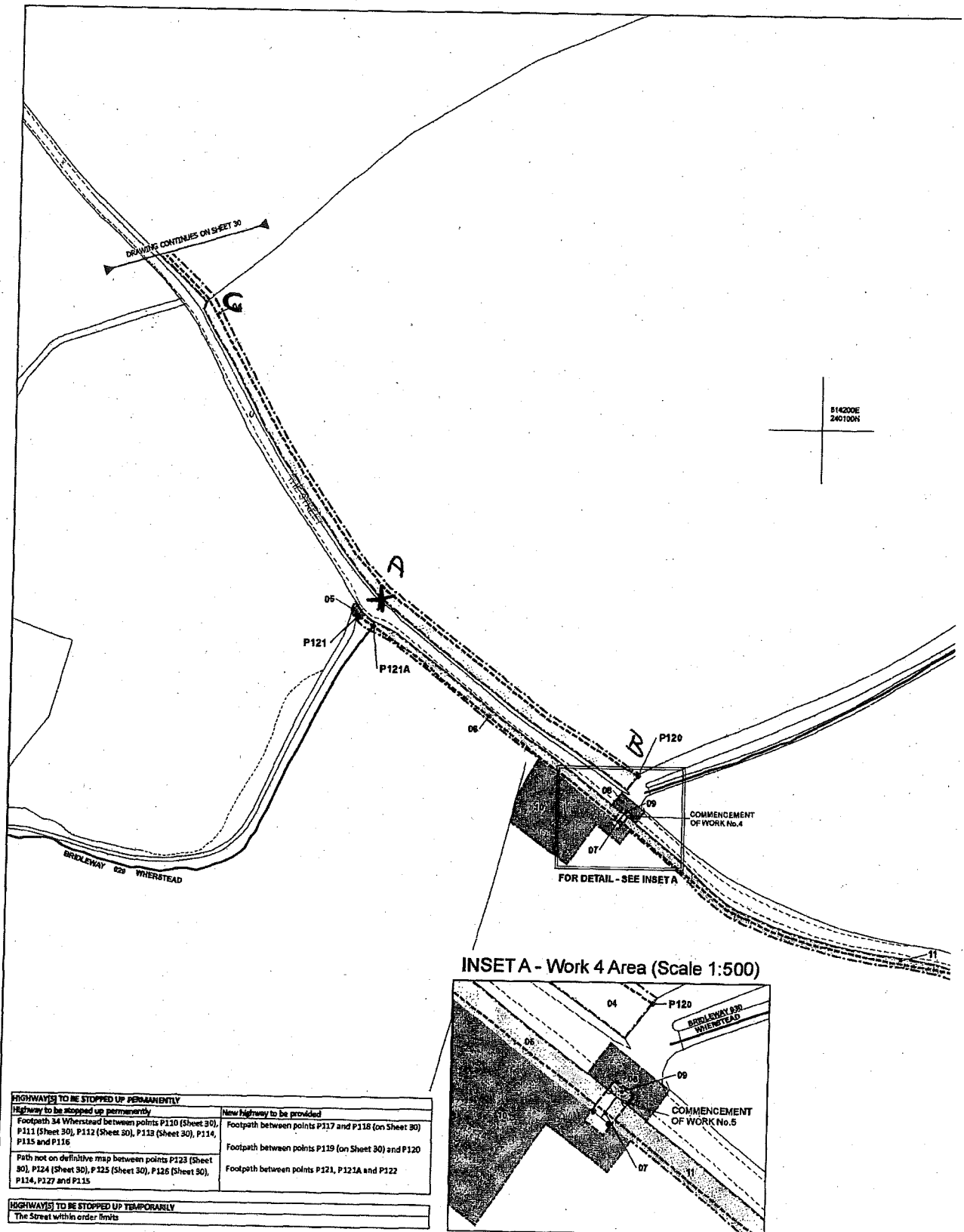
