Dear Mr. Hirst,

We are writing to register our objection to the proposal by Network Rail to attempt to close Newmarket's Weatherby pedestrian railway crossing.

This crossing is in constant use, and is used safely by hundreds of people each day, providing a link between the two sides of the town.

Any attempt to close this crossing would be cutting off direct access to the town for people living on the far side of the railway line.

The alternative routes are substantially longer and would involve a huge detour.

The crossing is used by many school children, and elderly residents.

Closure of this crossing would enforce an extremely long walk on those that can currently easily access the town centre by foot.

Please would you take our objections forward to the enquiry being held regarding this matter.
