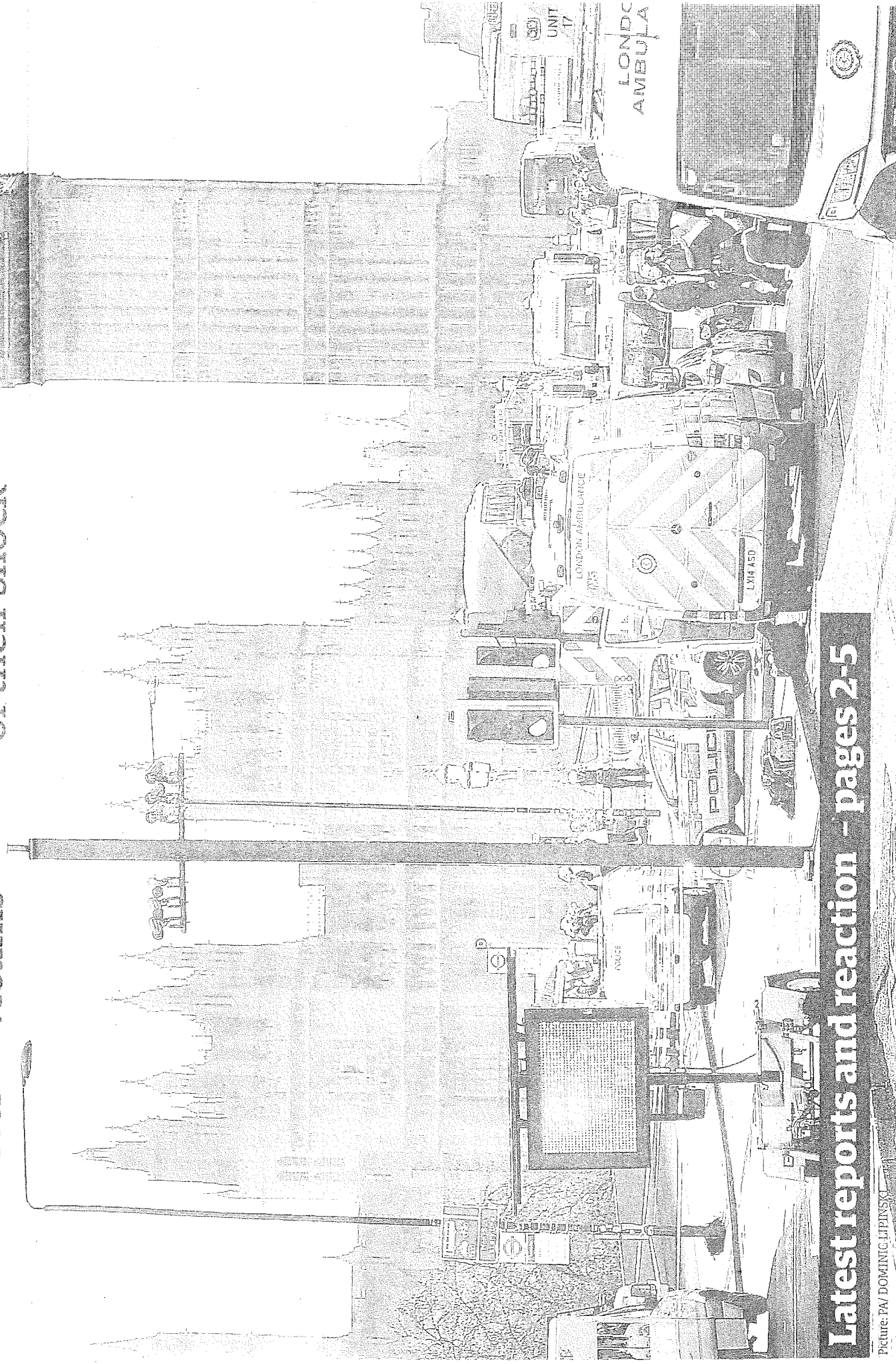

Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("Network Rail") of 1 Everholt Street, London, NW1 2DN, is applying to the Secretary of State for Transport under section 6 of the Transport and Works Act 1992, for the above-mentioned order under sections 1 and 5 of that Act.

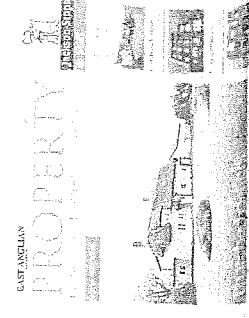

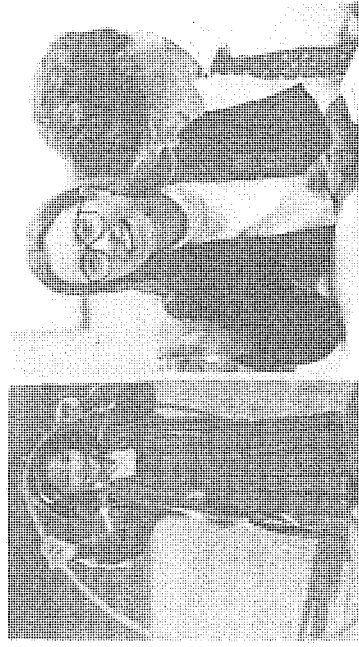

Car park row

An internationally renowned concert hall venue in Suffolk has pledged to scrap controversial plans for a new car park if the proposals harm the environment.

It has also been suggested by the venue that the car park could be grass surfaced and have sheep grazing on it - and not built from concrete.

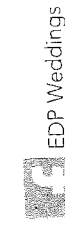

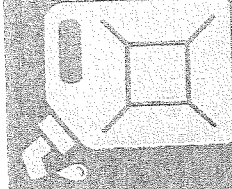

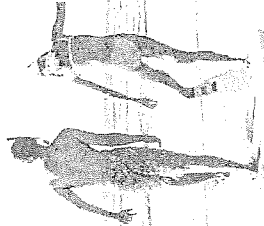

Network Rail applies for legal order

Rail bosses confirm closing

Despite hundreds of objections from users, Network Rail has confirmed its intention to close Newmarket's much used foot crossing.

And a large proportion of the town's residents could literally find themselves living on the wrong side of the tracks and facing a long detour to get in to the town if the track bosses' recommendations are agreed by the Transport Secretary.

The company has applied for a legal order to close 24 level crossings across Suffolk, including the one in Newmarket, as part of its plan to make railways safer after the Office

of Rail Regulation ordered it to embark on a nationwide programme of reducing risk following the deaths of Olivia Bazilinton, 14, and Charlotte Thompson, 13, at the Elsenham crossing in 2005. Network Rail was fined £1 million and since 2010 about 900 of the 7,000 crossings across the country have been shut.

New Cheveley Road resident Pat Collins, one of those who has fought the Newmarket closure, said: "It still seems ludicrous to me to close this crossing when there does not appear to be a safety issue.

The trains are never travelling fast because it is so near to the station and the health tunnel and you can see them coming from a distance. The alternative route that has been pro-

posed is a very long way round and I am thinking of challenging the Transport Secretary Chris Grayling to come and walk it and see what he thinks."

Richard Schofield, Network Rail's route managing director for Anglia, said: "We understand that public rights of way are an important part of life in this region and have maintained connectivity where possible in our plans. We are committed to improving safety and efficiency at level crossings as part of our railway upgrade plan."

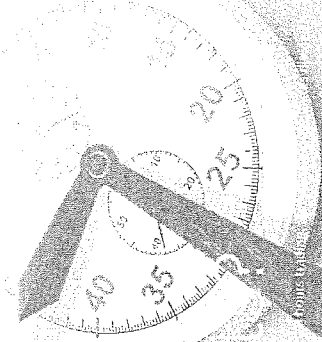

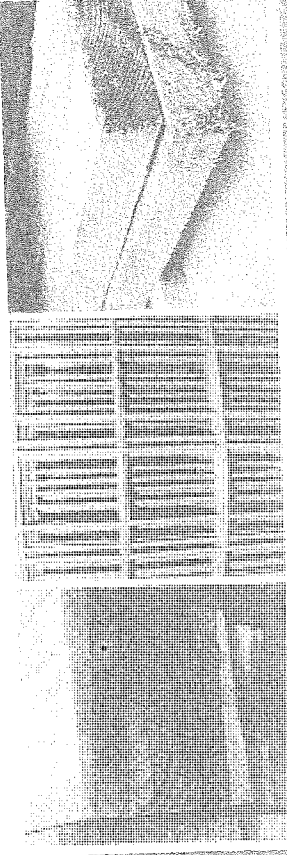

Exning Road proposal includes extra care apartments

Aldi steps in with plan for new store

Supermarket chain Aldi has confirmed it wants to open a new store in Newmarket creating 50 new jobs.

A spokeswoman for the global chain told the Journal it had bought the former gas works site in the town's Exning Road and planned to make a formal presentation to town councillors at a meeting of their planning committee next month.

The future of the site, which has been unused for more than 30 years, has been on the council's agenda for several months, but at a meeting on Monday councillors heard that Aldi had acquired it.

Company spokeswoman

Emily Annable confirmed Aldi was working with specialist elderly care provider Anchor to progress planning applications for a mixed use development at the site. Those proposals included an Aldi food store and extra care apartments for the elderly.

"The site already has planning consent for a Morrisons, but is now owned by Aldi, which has a long-standing requirement for a new store in Newmarket. It has agreed to sell the remaining site to Anchor," said a statement from the new owners.

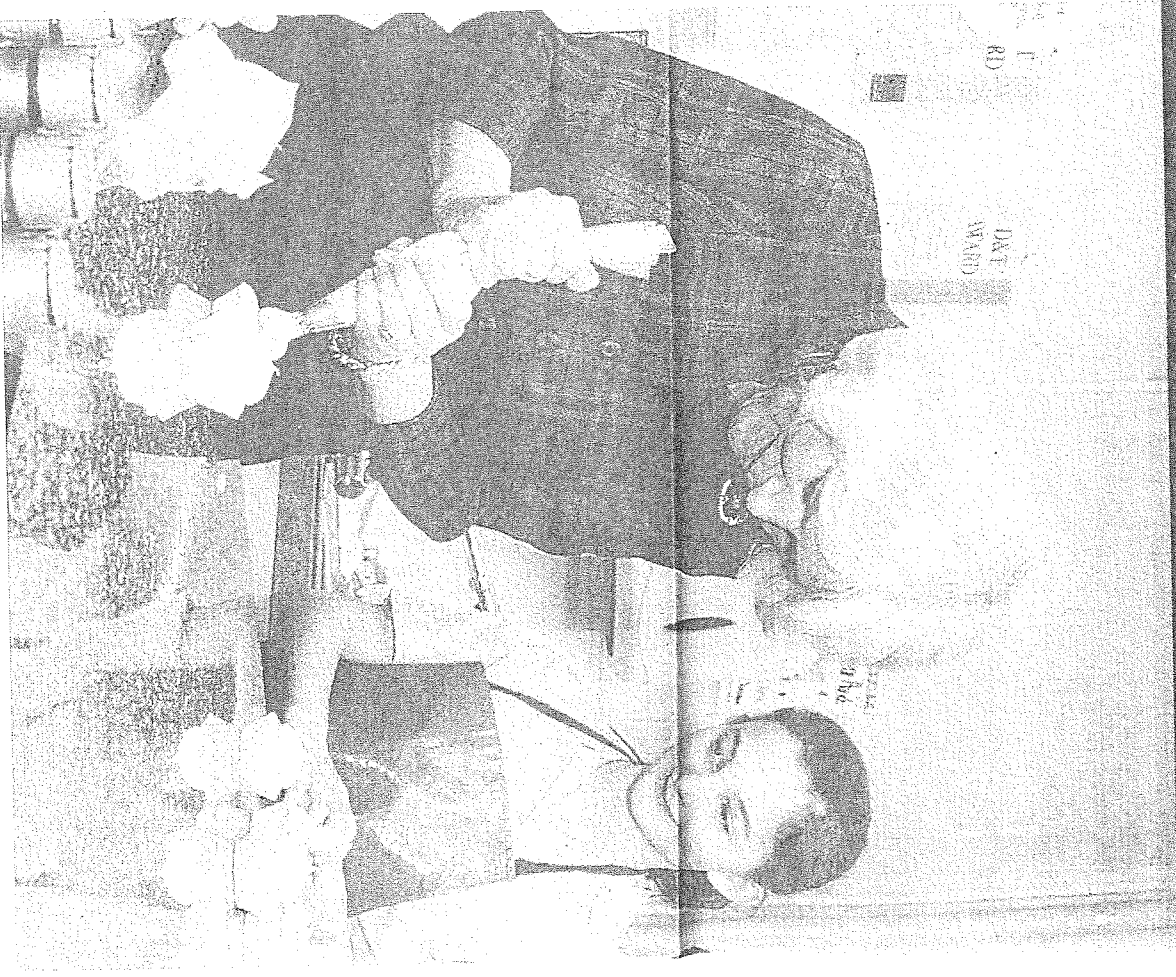
Ms Annable added: "Aldi and Anchor are delighted to announce this considerable joint investment in Newmarket and finally deliver a solution to this challenging site, which has been vacant for

some time. The site already has planning permission for a food store of over 50,000sqft, the new Aldi store will be around 60 per cent smaller, whilst the extra care apartment element will be sensitively integrated on the remainder of the site to deliver a mixed-use development.

"Before submitting the applications we will be meeting with local groups as well as inviting public comments through our extensive leaflet drop. We look forward to working together with the local community on this exciting project and subject to planning permission being granted aim to have the development completed by late 2019."

Mrs Pitkin had been stabbed multiple times.

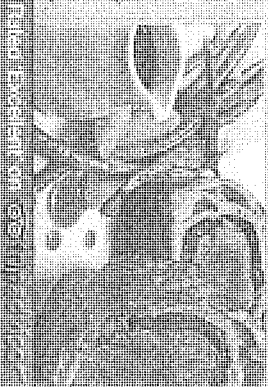
An inquest into their deaths, which opened in Ipswich yesterday morning, heard the well-known couple had been married for 37 years and had four adult children – two who lived at home.

Proposed Network Rail (Suffolk Level Crossing Reduction) Order

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER WHICH WOULD PERMANENTLY STOP UP AND REPLACE AND TEMPORARILY STOP UP A FOOTPATH AND PERMANENTLY STOP UP AND REPLACE AND TEMPORARILY STOP UP A FOOTPATH NOT ON THE DEFINITIVE MAP

Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("Network Rail") of 1 Eversholt Street, London, NW1 2DN, is applying to the Secretary of State for Transport under section 6 of the Transport and Works Act 1992, for the above-mentioned order under sections 1 and 5 of that Act.

This Order confers powers on Network Rail to close or downgrade the following level crossings:

County of Suffolk –

In the District of Forest Heath -

- Parish of Newmarket: S22 Weatherby
- Parish of Higham: S23 Higham

In the District of St. Edmundsbury -

- Parish of Barrow: S24 Higham Ground Frame
- Parish of Great Barton: S25 Cattishall

In the District of Mid Suffolk -

- Parish of Thurston: S27 Barrells and S28 Grove Farm
- Parish of Elmswell: S29 Hawk End Lane and S30 Lords No. 29
- Parish of Wetherden: S31 Mutton Hall
- Parish of Bacton: S11 Leggetts, S12 Gooderhams, S13 Fords Green and S69 Bacton
- Parish of Finningham: S16 Gislingham
- Parish of Gislingham: S17 Paynes
- Parish of Mellis: S18 Cowpasture Lane and S21 Abbotts
- Parish of Needham Market: S08 Stacpool
- Parish of Barham: S07 Broomfield

In the District of Babergh -

- Parish of Wherstead: S05 Pannington Hall
- Parish of Bentley: S04 Island and S03 Buxton Wood
- Parish of Brantham: S02 Brantham High Bridge and S01 Sea Wall.

In relation to these closures or downgrades the Order authorises the carrying out of works including the removal of the crossings and the diversion or redesignation of the status of certain footpaths, public roads, bridleways, byways open to all traffic and the creation of new rights of way. The Order also authorises the construction of the following specific works in connection with the creation of new public rights of way:

- In the District of St. Edmundsbury, Parish of Barrow: Work No. 1 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Mid Suffolk, Parish of Thurston: Work No. 2 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)

- In the District of Mid Suffolk, Parish of Bacton: Work No. 3 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Babergh, Parish of Wherstead: Work No. 4 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Babergh, Parish of Brantham: Works Nos. 5, 6 and 7 (footbridges carrying paths over a drain/watercourse).

The Order also confers powers for the construction and maintenance of works, including the creation of new rights of way; provides for compensation to be paid for any person who suffers loss as a result of the extinguishment of a private right of way; applies the compensation provisions of the Highways Act 1980 to the creation of new rights of way; permits Network Rail to acquire land and interests in land, including the temporary use of land, in connection with the construction of the scheduled and authorised works; authorises the temporary stopping up of streets; works in streets, traffic signs; and related purposes.

This application is not made subject to an environmental impact assessment.

The application contains a statement that a direction for deemed planning permission is being applied for.

The Order would authorise the permanent stopping up of footpath 011 Thurston between the points marked P029, P030A, P030, P033 and P032 on the plan attached and a footpath not on the definitive map between the points marked P027, P028A, P028, P037 and P036 on the plan attached. The replacement for these footpaths will be footpath between the points marked P032, P034 and P035 on the plan attached and footpath between points P030 and P031 on the plan attached on completion of the authorised works.

The Order would also authorise the temporary stopping up of footpath 011 Thurston between the points marked P029, P030A, P030, P033 and P032 on the plan attached and a footpath not on the definitive map between the points marked P027, P028A, P028, P037 and P036 on the plan attached

The period of the temporary stopping up applied for is for any reasonable time during the execution of the authorised works.

A copy of the application and of all plans and other documents submitted with it, may be inspected free of charge from 24 March to 5 May 2017 at the places and times (subject to Easter holiday closures) set out in the schedule below.
