

I, Will Jackson, confirm the following as a true statement:

- 15/1/18 – BK contacted the duty planning officer of West Suffolk Council (Forest Heath and St Edmundsbury) by telephone asking for their recommendations as to where to place Public Inquiry notices in addition to each affected level crossing. The PTA board of All Saints CEVA Primary School and the Jockey Club were suggested as potential locations for notices. No other locations were suggested.
- 15/01/18 – BK contacted Jockey Club Estates by telephone and were advised that they would not be permitted to post a notice on Jockey Club premises or via their website.
- 25/1/18 – I arrived at All Saints CEVA Primary School at approximately 3pm and asked at reception as to whether I would be able to erect a notice on one of the schools notice boards and take a photograph of the notice in place. The school receptionist advised that I could not post the notice in person and that all notices must be erected by the school's care taker. The care taker was not currently at the school and would therefore be asked to post the notice on the following day. I left the notice with the school receptionist who assured me it would be posted the following day.
- 27/02/18 – Mrs Bennett spoke with BK Partner, Andrew Prowse and confirmed to him that the notice remained place on their notice board. A confirmation by email was requested and is awaited.

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INQUIRY**

Notice is given pursuant to Rule 13(6) of the Transport and Works (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2004 that Mr Ian Jenkins BSc CEng MICE MCIWEM, an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport, will open a public inquiry into the application by Network Rail Infrastructure Limited ("the Applicant") for the proposed Network Rail (Suffolk Level Crossing Reduction) Order under section 6 of the Transport and Works Act 1992 at Ashlar House, 23 Eastern Way, Bury St Edmunds IP32 7AB at 10.00am on Tuesday 13 February 2016.

This Order confers powers on Network Rail to close or downgrade the following level crossings:

County of Suffolk -

In the District of Forest Heath -

- Parish of Newmarket: S22 Weatherby
- Parish of Higham: S23 Higham

In the District of St. Edmundsbury -

- Parish of Barrow: S24 Higham Ground Frame
- Parish of Great Barton: S25 Cattishall

In the District of Mid Suffolk -

- Parish of Thurston: S27 Barrells and S28 Grove Farm
- Parish of Elmwell: S29 Hawk End Lane and S30 Lords No. 29
- Parish of Wetherden: S31 Mutton Hall
- Parish of Bacton: S11 Leggatts, S12 Gooderhams, S13 Fords Green and S89 Bacton
- Parish of Fressingfield: S16 Gislegham
- Parish of Gislegham: S17 Paynes
- Parish of Mellis: S18 Cowpasture Lane and S21 Abbots
- Parish of Needham Market: S08 Stacpool
- Parish of Barham: S07 Broomfield

In the District of Babergh -

- Parish of Bentley: S04 Island and S03 Buxton Wood
- Parish of Brantham: S02 Brantham High Bridge and S01 Sea Wall

In relation to these closures or downgrades the Order authorises the carrying out of works including the removal of the crossings and the diversion or redesignation of the status of certain footpaths, public roads, aridways, byways open to all traffic and the creation of new rights of way. The Order also authorises the construction of the following specific works in connection with the creation of new public rights of way.

- In the District of St. Edmundsbury, Parish of Barrow: Work No. 1 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Mid Suffolk, Parish of Thurston: Work No. 2 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Mid Suffolk, Parish of Bacton: Work No. 3 (footbridge carrying path over a drain/watercourse)
- In the District of Babergh, Parish of Brantham: Works Nos. 5, 6 and 7 (footbridges carrying paths over a drain/watercourse)

The Order also confers powers for the construction and maintenance of works, including the creation of new rights of way; provides for compensation to be paid for any person who suffers loss as a result of the extinguishment of a private right of way; applies the compensation provisions of the Highways Act 1980 to the creation of new rights of way; permits Network Rail to acquire land and interests in land, including the temporary use of land, in connection with the construction of the scheduled and authorised works; authorises the temporary stopping up of streets, works in streets, traffic signs; and related purposes.
