I am writing to object to the extension of the railway line from Bodiam to Robertsbridge.

The argument for this line being extended is that it will bring more tourism to our already overcrowded corner of E. Sussex.

The main arguments in my opinion against the extension are:-

- a) The small village of Robertsbridge, on a flood plain, cannot take any more traffic.
- b) The 3 level crossings, that on the A21 being the major one, will add to our congested roads.
- c) A compulsory purchase order to make room for the railway will divide the owners' farms and destroy this area of meadow and woodland habitat which supports some very rare species of both wild flowers and wild life.
