Subject: FW: Rother Valley Railway (Bodiam to Robertsbridge Junction) Order

To whom it may concern.

I wish to object to the plans for the railway track from Bodiam to Robertsbridge for the following reasons:

1. There is no compelling case for compulsory purchase powers to be used for non-essential infrastructure/hobby.
2. No economic benefit to the majority of Robertsbridge residents.
3. Inadequate parking facilities in the village to cope with additional cars of visitors to the railway
4. Too many level crossings
5. Increased risk of flooding to areas of village not protected by flood defences
6. Destruction of habitat
7. This is a new railway as no existing track bed
8. New railway embankment will be much higher than previous railway because of the height of the A21
9. Noise, smoke, diesel fumes pollution from trains and cars held at level crossings
10. Strongly object to placing an obstruction on the A21. Road improvements are vital for economic benefits to Robertsbridge and surrounding areas
11. Public enquiry as documents out of date/inadequate.
