I wish to oppose the closing of the two level crossings, E41 and E42.

E41 Paget Road Wivenhoe: This is an important link for residents and has been in place since the railway was built. It has an excellent safety record.

E42 Sand Pit Alresford: This is used by walkers. The line of sight is excellent. Using this crossing is less dangerous than the suggested diversion using the railway bridge on a busy road with no pavements.
