

We act for E & K Benton Limited who own and farm land at Horndon on the Hill and Stanford le Hope, Essex.

Our clients have received four Notices (Notice Reference Nos. 1184, 1188, 1195 and 1200) in respect of the above proposed Network Rail Order and which affect land in their ownership.

These proposals include a proposed additional footpath immediately to the south of the A13 truck road and the Stanford Interchange which would increase significantly the public access on our client's land.

The proposals give no regard to the existing footpath network marked as Footpaths 36, 83 and 34 as coloured pink on the attached copy plan, which could be joined with the proposed footpath coloured brown (between points A-B) and then linked to the existing footpath (no.36 to point C).

Furthermore, the additional proposed route of public would create an additional liability to third parties for our client, in an area of increasing unauthorised access not just by those walking/riding over this land but also by motorbikes and fly tippers.

Public access would be maintained by following the route A-B-C on the attached plan without any requirement for further access along the proposed route as hatched black on our client's land.

Our client therefore formally objects to the proposals for an additional footpath along the routes hatched black and we look forward to receiving a response from your Department in this respect.
