Dear Sirs

I use the above crossing regularly to get to the top of the town by foot. I have never had or witnessed any sort of accident or near accident involving a train on this crossing. I have had two very close misses with a bus when taking the alternative route via the High Street.

The High Street bridge does not have a full width pavement on either side of the road. The pavement on the East of the bridge is only wide enough for one regular sized person, this is the pavement on which I have nearly been struck twice. For a bus to exit Station Road, the body work of the bus crosses the pavement and this is why I have nearly been hit twice.

Please do not shut this pedestrian crossing on safety grounds as the alternative is more dangerous.
