Finally, if this Public Footpath is confirmed and carried out then I would need to be assured that we would not incur any Agents fees or any other fees which may arise.

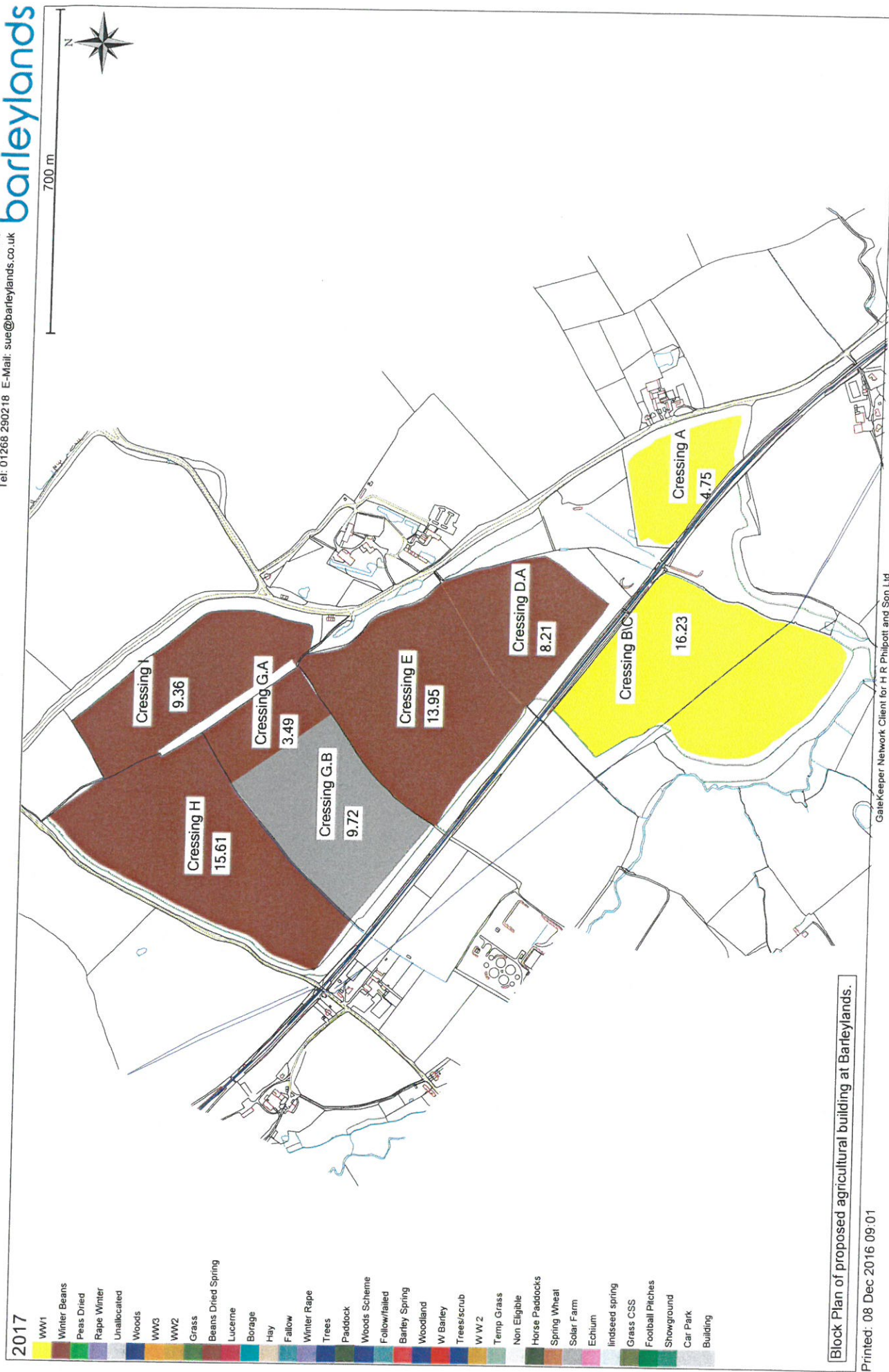

Analysis - Copy of Fields

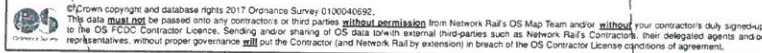
