What are your intentions following the works regarding the restoration of our privacy.

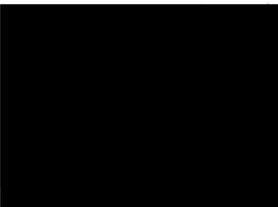
What measures will be put in place to restore train noise dampening currently provided by the established plants and shrubs.
