> Wivenhoe which I have used for nearly 40 years. The crossing is used

> frequently and, as far as I know, there has never been an incident

> there. It is used by parents taking their children to the local

> primary school and its closure will mean that parents will have little
> option but to use a busy, unmade road which has no safe area for
> children to walk in and, because cars park on both sides of the road,
> offers drivers a very limited view of the road ahead I hope you
> consider these comments as I feel that the closure of the Paget Road
> crossing will be likely to create more risk for pedestrians than is
