

I wish to object for the second time to the proposed new footpath between points 206 and 201 on the attached map. I agree with the closure of the footpath between points 206A and 209, It is seldom used and is an unnecessary hazard to users on the rail track and footpath. I do not agree with the new proposed path as above. It is not required as the path between points Bridleway EX 78/24 to point 210 and on to Little Tey Rd serves the same purpose .Also the footpath EX 78/7 Feering is not a definitive one and almost never used so there is no case to provide an extra connecting one along side the railway in our field . If this happened our field 588400E would have footpaths on three sides and a road on the other. This would have no benefit to wildlife or agricultural activities ,in fact it would be detrimental to both. For these reasons I strongly object to the proposed new path and wish to see it deleted from the proposals .
