HYSBYSIAD AM ATODIAD RHIF 2 I'R DATGANIAD AMGYLCHEDDOL YN UNOL AG ADRAN 105B O DDEDDF PRIFFYRDD 1980 (FEL Y'I DIWYGIWYD)

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn ystyried rhoi prosiect ar waith i adeiladu adran newydd o draffordd yr M4 i'r de o Gasnewydd, gan gynnwys gwaith ar-lein ac all-lein a gwelliannau i'r ffyrrd ymwl. Mae'r prosiect hwn yn ddarostyngedig i Asesiad o'r Effaith Amgylcheddol yn unol â Rhan VA o Ddeddf Priffyrd 1980 (fel y'i diwygiwyd) a Chyfarwyddeb 2011/92/EU y GE. Gan hynny, cyhoeddodd Gweinidogion Cymru Ddatganiad Amgylcheddol (DA) ar 10 Mawrth 2016.

Yn dilyn cyhoeddi'r DA, cyhoeddwyd Atodiad i'r Datganiad Amgylcheddol (ADA) ar 5 Medi 2016 a ddarparodd ddata ychwanegol ac asesiad amgylcheddol o newidiadau i ddyluniad y cynllun.

Mae ail Atodiad i'r Datganiad Amgylcheddol (ADA2) wedi ei lunio sydd, yn gryno:

- yn gwneud mân gywiriadau ac yn egluro rhai agweddau amgylcheddol o'r Cynllun a gyhoeddwyd yn well;
- yn darparu gwybodaeth a/neu ddata newydd; ac
- yn darparu asesiad amgylcheddol o newidiadau i rai strwythurau cynnal a chynnydd yn uchder y pontydd sydd i'w hadeiladu gan Weinidogion Cymru dros ddyfroedd mordwyol Dociau Casnewydd, Afon Wysg ac Afon Ebwy y mae diwygiad i Orchymyn drafft presennol yn ofynnol ar eu cyfer.

Bydd yr ADA2 hwn yn cael ei gyhoeddi ar 14 Rhagfyr 2016 a dylid ei ddarllen ar y cyd â'r DA, yr ADA a'r Crynodeb Annhechnegol, sy'n parhau i fod yn ddilys.

NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 105B OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 (AS AMENDED)

The Welsh Ministers are considering implementing a project for the construction of a new section of M4 motorway to the south of Newport to include online and off line works and side road improvements. This project is subject to an Environmental Impact Assessment in accordance with Part VA of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) and EC Directive 2011/92/EU. Therefore the Welsh Ministers published an Environmental Statement (ES) on 10 March 2016.

Following publication of the ES, an Environmental Statement Supplement (ESS) was published on 5 September 2016 which provided additional data and an environmental assessment of scheme design changes.

A second Environmental Statement Supplement (ESS2) has been prepared which in summary:

- makes minor corrections and gives greater clarity to some environmental aspects of the published Scheme;
- provides new information and/or data; and
- provides an environmental assessment of changes to some retaining structures and an increase in the height of the bridges to be constructed by the Welsh Ministers over the navigable waters of Newport Docks, the River Usk and the River Ebbw requiring an amendment to an existing draft Order

This ESS2 will be published on 14 December 2016 and should be read in conjunction with the published ES, the ESS and Non-Technical Summary, which
