You state that "it would not be possible to construct a footpath along the line suggested due to the level differences. The plans that have been produced by Network Rail simply fail to recognise this". Following the most recent site visit had with your colleague Robin Chapple of Kier and Nick Eddy of Network Rail on 05 November 2018 regarding the alignment and levelling of the proposed route, Network Rail wish to clarify and confirm that it is possible to construct the proposed footpath between P034 and P029 using plot 40 on the western perimeter of the Kier development. The footpath proposal remains within the Order limits as shown in the original plan attached (entitled Revision Date 22-08-2018, Replacement Sheet 07, E04 Parndon Mill Level Crossing) and sent in the email to you on 06 December 2018 from Liz Noonan of Network Rail.

Should the Order powers be granted, the difference in levelling in plot 40 to construct the footpath will be accommodated through regrading, which will be considered at detailed design stage.

We acknowledge that Kier may wish to maintain their objection to the proposed Order, of which E04 Parndon Mill is to be heard at the Public Inquiry week commencing 28 January 2019.


