We have asked to comment on the pre- CMC note and the Womble Bond Dickinson letter dated 3 March (WBD Letter).

The only comments we wish to make are as follows:

Public Participation:

The PCAA welcome as much public involvement as possible with people being allowed to attend the hearings at the venue rather than on line, if possible. Our view is that public participation should be at the beginning and end of the Inquiry and following the closure of topic.

Ordering of the Issues and Evidence

We ask that the topics be run in this order:

Forecasting Socio-economics Noise

We have three experts who will address forecasting in their evidence. One is our climate change expert and the other is our socio-economic expert. We only want to call these experts once to save time for them and the inquiry. If we can group Forecasting next to socio economic tht will at least reduce potential attendance at the inquiry and will ensure some evidence can be heard close together so any forecasting comments are not issues being raised again.

We attach our current list of witness which is potential subject to change and have highlighted where they are professionals.

Main Issues – (we prefer the Inspectors issues list)

We favour the issues as set out in the PINS note rather than the WBD letter subject to some revisions below.

d. Highway matters – is public transport provision adequate to reduce reliance on private car, issues related to off-site car parking *and whether the surface access infrastructure strategy is able to support development to 12 mppa.*

f. the effects of the development on noise, disturbance and residential amenity;

g. The impact of the proposed development on greenhouse gas emissions and compatibility with national and local planning policies on climate change, national climate change law and the UK's international climate change commitments *including examination of the Sixth carbon Budget recommendations by the Committee on Climate Change* (our words in italics supplement the suggested wording from BAAN)

h. The extent to which the development would be consistent with overall economic growth in the United Kingdom including the issue of displacement of passengers from other areas (we suggest that these words replace the wording proposed by PINS)

i. The proposed development must show that the economic and other benefits have not been overstated and those that cause environmental and social harm have not been understated (we suggest that this is included as an additional point)

Timing

The only timing issue we have at present is that Our climate Change witness Tim Johnson cannot make the week of the 2nd - 6 August but with CC programmed later in the running order this shouldn't be a problem.
