



WHEREAS the Environment Agency has submitted for confirmation to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs scheme amendments made by them under section 17(3)(c) to the River Medway (Flood Reilef) Act 1976 ('the 1976 Act'), which would authorise them to vary the Scheme for the operation of the Leigh Flood Storage Area. The 1976 Act provided limited detail on the statutory process to be followed and therefore we are taking best practice under the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure Rules) 2007, which have been suitably modified so as to be used for this inquiry. 
The Scheme, which is subject to the public inquiry, will increase the maximum stored water level in the Leigh Flood Storage Area from 28.05m Above Ordnance Datum (AOD) to 28.6m AOD. This will include works to modify and improve the gates and mechanical infrastructure at the Leigh Flood Storage Area main embankment and works to raise the embankment between the cattle arch bridge and Ensfield Road.

#### ANNEX

### River Medway Flood Relief Scheme (Leigh Flood Storage Area variation): Inquiry Procedure Rules

- The power to hold an inquiry is provided for by section 17(3)(f)(i) of the River Medway (Flood Relief) Act 1976, but there are no rules provided: therefore it is proposed that these rules are based on the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure Rules) 2007 (CPO Rules 2007)1, suitably modified to the key provisions below.
- Notice of intention to hold an inquiry -
  - (1) Where a public local inquiry is to be held written notice must be served, by the Minister, on objectors and the Order promoting authority, i.e. the Environment Agency.
  - (2) The Notice of Intention of Inquiry is to be served also upon other interested parties
  - (3) The date of the notices served pursuant to points (1) and (2) above is the "relevant date".
  - (4) The Inquiry is to be heldt less than 13 weeks and not more
  - than 22 weeks from the relevant date.
    (5) The Inquiry is to be held at a suitable local venue.
  - (This notice will be published in local newspapers, the London Gazette and in appropriate places in the locality.)
- Pre-Inquiry Meeting-If I appears desirable to the Minister, a pre-inquiry meeting may be held and the Minister shall give notice of the intention to hold a pre-inquiry meeting, which meeting shall be held not later than 16 weeks after the relevant date.
- Statements of Case 
  (1) The EA, as Order promoter, is also required to submit its

  Statement of Case for the Order not later than 6 weeks after the

  relevant data.

  (2) The Objectors must produce their Statements of Case not later

  than 8 weeks after the relevant date.

  (3) Where the EA refer to documents in their statement of case,
  these must be sent to the objectors, or alternatively then my be placed
  in such places as the objectors may be able to attend and reduces of
  such placement must accompany the statement of the sent of the objectors.
