Bristol Airport Planning Application – 18/P/5118/OUT

Sent on behalf of and with the authority of the Chairman and Councillors of Kingston Seymour Parish Council.

With reference to the above planning application made by the Bristol Airport Authority regarding the increase in passenger numbers to 12million/annum we would like to respond to the public consultation as follows.

Kingston Seymour Parish Council are in principal supportive of the application provided the following planning conditions are applied

- No aircraft are to turn over the village of Kingston Seymour on take-off or landing. Any turning should only commence once the aircraft is over the Bristol channel. The reason for this is to reduce pollution and environmental noise impact within the village.
- No additional (from the current limit of 4,000 per annum) night time (11:00pm to 6:00am) aircraft movements are to be permitted. The reason for this is environmental noise impact to residence of Kingston Seymour.

Furthermore, we are very concerned about additional traffic movements in the area. We do not consider the traffic impact assessment to be adequate, nor is it coordinated with the requirements of the wider North Somerset plans and related developments within the area.

We are concerned that the additional traffic using the M5 at Junction 21 and congestion at the Congresbury Traffic Lights will encourage additional traffic to utilise Junction 20 at Clevedon and the B3133 Clevedon-Yatton Road and surrounding country lanes, all of which are unsuitable and will become very congested at peak periods. We would like to see how this issue will be properly managed.

Until these points of concern are satisfactorily resolved' either by North Somerset Council or the Airport Authority we will not be able to fully support the Application.
