As a manager of a local business in Brightling, I see very little negative impact. The additional visits will be welcome.

I live just down from the proposed crossing and have no concerns of the occasional closures. If anything, it will help to reduce the speed of vehicles on the main road.

The rail will be quite close (~100 m) to my rear fence and again have no concerns. I believe my property value will improve. No issues with noise or air pollution as it'll be a light usage system.

The A21 crossing is of little concern as the times when closed will be outside peak times and limited times of the year. The pedestrian crossing is acceptable and that is used far more often in peak times and year round.

The additional tourist will help keep shops viable and allow some that have closed to reopen. This is great.
