Good morning

The Inspector picked up a difference between Sheet 5 of the Order plans as per the on-line core documents and the hard copy application set.

The online version of Sheet 5 is dated 29 March 2018 compared with 17 March for the printed version. The difference between the two is that the Order limits have been pulled in to remove plots 73, 89 and 90 from the later version.

The three plots are all listed in the application (and revised) Book of Reference as "Number not used" in any event.

We have also checked the other sheets of the Order plans. Sheet 3 has been replaced in any event, but we noticed that sheets 2 and 8 also bore different dates so we checked these out.

With regard to sheet 2, the 29 March version showed the limits of deviation pulled in at the extreme eastern end – beyond the cut line. The "pulled in" limits are consistent with what is shown on Sheet 3.

We noticed that the CAD date on sheet 8 was also different but the plan itself was unchanged. J.C. White has advised Gardner Crawley of RVR by telephone this morning that this may simply be the result of the CAD file being opened and resaved with a different date, rather than necessarily implying a change in the content. That would be consistent with our comparison of the differently dated plans.
