Thank you for your letter of 13 March 2019 regarding further information on the above application for planning permission. On the basis of this information, we offer the following advice to assist your authority in determining the application.

Historic England Advice

The Technical Note (Wood March 2019) provides the clarity we sought in respect of the potential effects of noise to designated heritage assets identified as receptors during the EIA process. We note that the scheduled monument identified as SM 1008291 will be subject to a temporary increase in ground noise during the construction period of the proposed Silver Zone Car Park. We also note that the listed Church of St Mary and St Peter (LB 1320916) will experiance an increase in daytime noise levels but that the increase will be below the threshold of perceptibility. In our view, none of the designated heritage assets will suffer a loss of significance that could reasonably be equated to that described in the NPPF as 'substantial harm' (paragraph 193).

Recommendation

Historic England has no objection to the application on heritage grounds. We consider that the application meets the requirements of the NPPF, in particular paragraph number 189.
