YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

My wife and I object to this application and support its refusal as follows.

- 1. There should be no further increase to night flying. The requested increase is both extremely excessive and unfair. People should be entitled to a reasonable night's sleep between 11.30pm and 6am. The request for no seasonal restrictions would literally be a nightmare.
- 2. The proposed improvements to the roads are far too restricted eg the other access roads should be significantly improved such as the A370.
