Airport expansion plans: letter from local businesses.

Bristol Airport Planning Inquiry APP/D0121/W/20/3259234

Dear Inspectors,

We, the undersigned businesses, write to formally object to the expansion plans of Bristol Airport and intend this letter to be read out at the public inquiry deciding on these plans. The Inquiry is due to start on July 20th 2021.

The science is indisputable - we must decrease our carbon emissions immediately whilst reducing our consumption of the earth's resources. Consecutive reports from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) have advised us of the need for urgent, far-reaching, and unprecedented changes to all aspects of society. The government has accepted the Sixth Carbon Budget, which will require deep cuts in carbon emissions between now and 2035. The Committee on Climate Change has advised them that this will require "no net increase in UK airport capacity. The fact that the UK Parliament and many local authorities (including North Somerset, Bristol, Bath and Northeast Somerset and WECA) have declared Climate Emergencies demonstrates the importance of this issue, and the national and local intentions to address it.

We the undersigned are businesses who recognise the importance and urgency of the Climate and Ecological Emergencies that we face. Reduction of carbon emissions and other sustainability practices have become the 'norm' in the ways that we work, and they are integrated into how we run our businesses, and the decisions that we make. We also recognise that good business, profitability, and growing the economy do not have to be in conflict with reducing our carbon emissions or improving our environmental sustainability in fact, we have found the opposite; being sustainable can be good for our businesses, as so many businesses in and around the Bristol area have proved. We want our businesses to grow, and for the local, national, and international economies to thrive, and we see ourselves as part of that.

It is with this in mind that we write to you asking that the application by Bristol Airport to expand in this appeal is rejected. Any expansion of Bristol Airport will push us ever further towards climate and ecological breakdown but just to be clear: we do not want Bristol Airport to close; we just think it is big enough.

The airport's expansion plans involve two million extra passengers a year resulting in up to a million extra tonnes of CO2 and other greenhouse gas emissions. These emissions will instantly wipe-out any savings that we are achieving by our actions, not to mention dwarf Bristol's proposed reductions. These greenhouse gas emissions are totally incompatible with

the changes that we local businesses make to meet the challenge of the Climate and Ecological Emergencies.

We have further grave concerns regarding loss of green belt, increases in localised road-traffic, air and noise pollution, and all of the effects of these on environmental and human health.

We are writing to you to state categorically that Bristol Airport must not be allowed to expand further. Such an expansion would contravene our international, national, and local obligations and undermine entirely all the work that we are doing as local businesses to reduce our collective carbon footprint.

The airport argues that local business want expansion, but we believe that a significant number of local businesses do not. Please reject this application.
