COMPLIANCE WITH THE NOTIFICATION AND PUBLICITY REQUIREMENTS OF THE ABOVE RULES

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This note sets out how Northumberland County Council ("NCC") has complied with its obligations under the Transport and Works (Applications and Objections Procedure) (England and Wales) Rules 2006 ("the Application Rules") and the Transport and Works (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2004 ("the Inquiry Rules") to:
 - 1.1.1 identify all those affected by the proposed Northumberland Line Order ("the proposed Order");
 - 1.1.2 publicise and notify owners, occupiers and others about the application for the proposed Order;
 - 1.1.3 make information about the proposed Order available for inspection;
 - 1.1.4 serve a Statement of Case on the Secretary of State together with copies of documents to be referred to;
 - 1.1.5 serve a Statement of Case on each statutory objector and others together with a list of those documents to be referred to;
 - 1.1.6 give notice of where the Statement of Case and those documents referred to in it can be inspected;
 - 1.1.7 publicise details of the inquiry; and
 - 1.1.8 serve proofs of evidence.
- 2. Affidavits prepared in compliance with rule 10(8) of the Application Rules which formally prove NCC's compliance with the Application Rules have been sworn by Harry Smith of Pinsent Masons LLP, Helen Swinburn of NCC and Melissa Griffiths of Land Referencing Services and submitted to the Department for Transport. These affidavits are appended to this note and contain further commentary and evidence as to compliance with the required statutory procedures.

THE APPLICATION RULES

3. BOOK OF REFERENCE

- 3.1 Under Rules 10(4) and 12(8) of the Application Rules, NCC is required to submit with the application for the proposed Order a book of reference containing the names of:
 - 3.1.1 all owners, lessees, tenants or occupiers of land proposed to be compulsorily acquired or used;
 - 3.1.2 all those entitled to easements or other private rights over such land and those who would be entitled to a notice to treat if the land was being acquired under the Compulsory Purchase Act 1965; and

- 3.1.3 various statutory bodies and organisations.
- 3.2 Under Rule 15(1) of the Application Rules, all of these people must be served with notice of the application. In compliance with this, on 28 May 2021 Land Referencing Services served, by the Royal Mail Special Delivery Service, notice of the application for the proposed Order on every person listed in the book of reference.
- 3.3 A number of notices were required to be re-served using First Class post during June and early July 2021 to account for the initial notices being unable to be delivered. This is further detailed in the affidavit of Melissa Griffiths.
- 3.4 Certain affected landowners (Plessey Checks Farming Limited, the Honourable Matthew White Ridley and the Right Honourable Matthew White Fifth Viscount Ridley) subsequently made NCC aware that some of the notices originally served under Rule 15(1) were invalid. Consequently, Land Referencing Services re-served these parties in July 2021. With agreement from the Department for Transport, these parties were given extra time to submit an objection to the proposed Order.
- 3.5 Where it was impossible to serve a notice pursuant to Rule 15(1) of the Application Rules on a person because a name or address could not be ascertained after reasonable inquiry, a copy of the relevant notice was affixed conspicuously to some building or object on the land. A list of the properties where notices were so affixed is contained in the affidavit of Melissa Griffiths.
- 3.6 Rule 12(10) of the Application Rules provides that the book of reference only need include those names which have been ascertained by the applicant after making diligent inquiry at the beginning of a period of 28 days ending with the date of the application. Rule 12(11) provides that, if the applicant has made diligent inquiries to obtain the necessary information, an application for an Order is not invalid because there are errors or omissions in the book of reference.
- 3.7 NCC considers that it, through the work undertaken by Land Referencing Services, has undertaken 'diligent inquiries' for the purposes of Rule 12(10) of the Application Rules, and that the addresses of the persons and bodies named in the book of reference are the proper addresses for those persons and bodies as described by section 66 of the Transport and Works Act 1992.

4. SCHEDULE 5 AND 6 PARTIES - NOTICES

- 4.1 Application Rule 13(3) requires NCC to serve copies of the application documents on the bodies identified in Column 2 of Schedule 5 to the Application Rules in the case of an application authorising any of the works described within Column 1 of that Schedule.
- 4.2 Application Rule 14(4) requires NCC to notify those identified in Column 2 of Schedule 6 to the Application Rules in the case of an application authorising any of the works described within Column 1 of that Schedule.
- 4.3 Application Rules 13(1), (2), and (4) specify various other bodies that must be notified in certain circumstances.
- 4.4 NCC notified all of those required to be served with notice by Application Rules 13 and 14, as set out in the affidavits mentioned above. The bodies that were served are listed in the exhibits to those affidavits.

- 4.5 As set out in the Consultation Report **[APP-04]**, NCC also consulted all of the relevant statutory bodies set out in the Application Rules before making the application for the proposed Order.
- 4.6 In addition to the statutory notice requirements, the application was also advertised as set out below.

5. **INSPECTION AND ADVERTISEMENT OF THE ORDER**

- 5.1 Application Rule 14 requires NCC to publish notice of the application in the *London Gazette* and on two occasions in a local newspaper (see exhibit HS 4 in the affidavit sworn by Harry Smith).
- 5.2 Notices of the application were required to be displayed at intervals of not more than 5 kilometres along the length of the proposed route, and notices also had to be displayed as close as reasonably practicable to each point of extinguishment, diversion, stopping-up or restriction of a highway. Under Rule 14(9) NCC was required to use its best endeavours to ensure that those notices continued to be displayed in a legible form until the objection deadline (which in this case was 8 July 2021).
- 5.3 Under Application Rule 14, the application and accompanying documents are required to be available for inspection free of charge at reasonable hours in the areas to which the proposal relates. Copies of the application documents are also required to be provided, where requested, for a reasonable charge, in accordance with Application Rule 14(10).
- 5.4 On 5 February 2021, NCC received a waiver direction given by the Secretary of State under rule 18 [APP-09] confirming that it was not required to give details of places where a copy of the application and accompanying documents could be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours until the expiry date for objections, pursuant to Rule 14(5)(e). Instead, the documents were required to be available for inspection on a website maintained by NCC.
- 5.5 Notwithstanding the waiver direction, NCC made copies of all documents submitted available in locations across Northumberland and North Tyneside and made arrangements for the documents to be made available for inspection until at least 8 July 2021.
- 5.6 NCC complied with its obligations under Application Rule 14 (and the waiver direction) in the following ways:
 - 5.6.1 NCC uploaded a copy of the application and of all the documents submitted with it to the website <u>www.northumberland.gov.uk/Highways/Transport-policy/northumberland-line.aspx</u>.
 - 5.6.2 Copies of all of the application documents were available from NCC for a reasonable charge.
 - 5.6.3 In accordance with Application Rules 14(6) and (7), as set out in the affidavit of Melissa Griffiths, notices were displayed on, or as close as reasonably practicable to the sites of proposed works (at not more than 5 km intervals), and at places as near as practicable to each point of proposed highway extinguishment, diversion, stopping-up or restriction, at places accessible to the public. These notices were posted not later than 28 May 2021. Some notices disappeared or were removed but replacement notices were displayed where necessary, in compliance with Application Rule 14(9).
 - 5.6.4 The application for the Order was advertised in the following newspapers on the following dates (see exhibit HS 4 in affidavit sworn by Harry Smith):

- (a) the News Post Leader on 21 and 28 May 2021;
- (b) the *Newcastle Chronicle* on 21 and 28 May 2021; and
- (c) the London Gazette on 26 May 2021.
- 5.6.5 NCC was not required by the Application Rules to be on hand at the inspection points to answer queries relating to the application documents and plans. Nevertheless, NCC was contactable by telephone throughout the objection period for the public to raise any queries about the proposed Order or any aspect of the application documents.
- 5.7 As a result of design refinements made following the submission of the application, NCC has amended the alignment of a replacement right of way at Palmersville Dairy to be authorised by the proposed Order. As a result, with agreement from the Department for Transport:
 - 5.7.1 on 7 October 2021 NCC sent a letter to the parties prescribed by the Application Rules with an interest in rights of way, advising them of the proposed amendments to the replacement right of way; and
 - 5.7.2 site notices were placed in the vicinity of both the previous and revised alignments,
- The letters and site notices advised that objections or other representations on the revised proposals could be made to the Secretary of State by 5 November 2021. Some site notices disappeared or were removed but replacement notices were displayed where necessary, in compliance with Application Rule 14(9).

6. **OBJECTION PERIOD**

- 6.1 Under Application Rules 4(1) and 14(1) the expiry date for objections is the date specified in the notice published in the *London Gazette*, which must be not less than 42 days from the date on which the application is made.
- 6.2 The application for the proposed Order was made on 26 May 2021, and the date specified in the *London Gazette* notice was 8 July 2021. This constituted a 42 day period in which to object, in compliance with Application Rules 4(1) and 14(1).
- 6.3 As noted above, an extension to the deadline for objections was given, with agreement from the Department for Transport, to Plessey Checks Farming Limited, the Honourable Matthew White Ridley and the Right Honourable Matthew White Fifth Viscount Ridley, following the re-service of notices of the application.
- 6.4 An additional four-week objection period applied to the revised proposals at Palmersville Dairy as agreed with the Department for Transport

THE INQUIRY RULES

7. STATEMENT OF CASE

7.1 Under Rule 7(1) of the Inquiry Rules, NCC must serve a Statement of Case on the Secretary of State and on each statutory objector and any other person who has notified the Secretary of State that they wish to appear at the inquiry. By a letter from the DfT dated 9 July NCC was informed that it was required to serve its Statement of Case by 3 September 2021. NCC duly served its Statement of Case on that date on the required persons.

- 7.2 Inquiry Rule 7(2) required NCC to serve on the Secretary of State any documents which it intended to refer to or put in evidence at that stage, and NCC did so on 3 September 2021.
- 7.3 Inquiry Rule 7(2) also requires NCC to serve a notice giving the names of all places within each area in which the proposals contained in the application are to have effect (or as close as reasonably possible to any such area), where a copy of every document or the relevant part of any document which the applicant intends to refer to or put in evidence may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours until the date of commencement of the inquiry. Appendix B to the Statement of Case, served pursuant to Inquiry Rule 7(1), gave details of the locations where these documents could be inspected.

8. NOTIFICATION OF INQUIRY

- 8.1 Under Inquiry Rule 13(6), NCC is required, not later than 2 weeks before the date fixed for the commencement of an inquiry, to:
 - 8.1.1 post a notice of the inquiry in a conspicuous place or (in the case of an application for an order making provision for land-based linear works of more than 5 kilometres in length) at intervals of not more than 5 kilometres on, or as close as reasonably practicable to, the land to which the powers sought in the application relate;
 - 8.1.2 post a notice of the inquiry in one or more places where public notices are usually posted in the area in which the proposals contained in the application relate; and
 - 8.1.3 publish a notice of the inquiry by local advertisement in the area in which the proposals contained in the application are to have effect.
- 8.2 NCC posted the inquiry notice at numerous places along the proposed route and in several places where public notices are usually posted in the area (certain local libraries) in which the proposals contained in the application relate. These notices were posted on or before 11 October 2021 and were checked regularly and replaced where necessary in accordance with Inquiry Rule 13(8).
- 8.3 A notice was published in the *News Post Leader* on 15 October 2021 and the *Newcastle Chronicle* on 15 October 2021.

9. **PROOFS OF EVIDENCE**

- 9.1 Inquiry Rule 16 requires NCC to send copies of its proofs of evidence to the inspector, with written summaries where the proofs are more than 1,500 words, no later than 4 weeks before the inquiry. On 12 October 2021, NCC's proofs of evidence were sent to the inspector and these proofs included those documents referred to in them that had not been previously mentioned in the List of Documents appended to NCC's Statement of Case. Those documents were made available for inspection on request at the locations referred to in paragraph 7.3 above in accordance with Inquiry Rule 16(6).
- 9.2 At the same time, NCC served copies of the proofs of evidence on all statutory objectors and on those who had served a Statement of Case. The proofs of evidence were made available for inspection on request in the same locations as are referred to in paragraph 7.3 above in accordance with Inquiry Rule 16(8).





HIGH SPEED RAIL (LONDON – WEST MIDLANDS) ACT 2017 COMPULSORY PURCHASE (VESTING DECLARATIONS) ACT 1981 TO: PERSONS HAVING A RELEVANT INTEREST IN THE LAND DESCRIBED IN THE SCHEDULE HERETO

1. The High Speed Rail (London – West Midlands) Act 2017 ("the High Speed Rail Act") received Royal Assent on 23 February 2017.

2. The Secretary of State for Transport (the "Acquiring Authority") is authorised under section 4 of the High Speed Rail Act to exercise powers under section 4(1) of the High Speed Rail Act to acquire compulsorily so much of the land within the limits of the High Speed Rail Act as may be required for Phase One purposes¹.

3. By virtue of section 4(4) of the High Speed Rail Act, the Compulsory Purchase (Vesting Declarations) Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") applies as if the High Speed Rail Act were a compulsory purchase order.

4. By virtue of paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 6 to the High Speed Rail Act, Parts 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 (exception of minerals from compulsory purchase and regulation of working of mines or minerals underlying an authorised undertaking) have effect in relation to land to which section 4(1) of the High Speed Rail Act applies as if it were comprised in a compulsory purchase order providing for the incorporation with that order of those Parts of that Schedule.

5. Paragraph 2(1) of Part 2 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 provides that an acquiring authority shall not be entitled to any mines under the land comprised in the compulsory purchase order unless they have been expressly purchased, and all mines under the land are to be deemed to be excepted out of the conveyance of that land unless expressly named and conveyed. Paragraph 3 of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 makes provision where the owner of any mines or minerals in the land desires to work them.

6. Pursuant to section 3A of the 1981 Act² before making a general vesting declaration ("GVD") under section 4 of the 1981 Act the Acquiring Authority must, in a notice which is (a) given to every person with a relevant interest in the land with respect to which a GVD is to be made (other than a mortgagee who is not in possession); and (b) published in the London Gazette, include the particulars in section 3A(3) of the 1981 Act³.

7. Notice pursuant to section 3A of the 1981 Act was first given and published in respect of the land described in Schedule 1 hereto ("Land") on 15 October 2019.

8. Having given and published notice pursuant to section 3A of the 1981 Act on 15 October 2019 in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 4 of the 1981 Act, the Acquiring Authority executed a GVD on 05 November 2019 to vest in the Acquiring Authority the Land together with the right to enter upon and take possession of the Land ("GVD 291") and the Land vested in the Acquiring Authority on 14 February 2020. The mines and minerals in the Land were not expressly named in GVD 291, so by virtue of the operation of paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 6 to the High Speed Rail Act and Parts 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 (exception of minerals from compulsory purchase and regulation of working of minerals underlying an authorised undertaking), the mines and minerals did not vest in the Acquiring Authority.

9. It is now expedient that such mines and minerals should be vested in the Acquiring Authority and for the avoidance of doubt, further notice is hereby given pursuant to section 3A of the 1981 Act⁴ that the Acquiring Authority intends to execute a GVD to acquire the freehold mines and minerals comprised in the Land, together with the right to take possession of the mines and minerals, to win and work them and all related ancillary rights.

10. Pursuant to section 3A(3) of the 1981 Act, a Statement of the Effect of Parts 2 and 3 of the 1981 Act is contained in Part 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice, which provides an explanation of the process for and effect of a GVD in respect of the mines and minerals in the Land described in Schedule 1 hereto. Part 1 of Schedule 2 to this notice also invites any person who would be entitled to claim compensation if a GVD were executed under section 4 of the 1981 Act to give the Acquiring Authority information about the person's name, address and interest in the land using the form set out in Part 2 of Schedule 2.

11. For the avoidance of doubt, the Acquiring Authority intends to purchase the freehold mines and minerals together with the right to take possession of the mines and minerals, to win and work them and all related ancillary rights, in the land described in Schedule 1 hereto and, if so, will expressly name them in the GVD.
