Network Rail have received a copy of your correspondence dated 30 July to the Department for Transport's Transport Infrastructure Planning Unit (DfT Ref: REP04) in respect of Network Rail's Cambridge South Infrastructure Enhancement Order application.

We note your concerns in respect of potential impact the temporary roadway (for construction traffic) will have on the White Hill Farm Scheduled Monument and are working closely with Historic England and the Cambridgeshire Historic Environment team to ensure that all mitigation proposed is acceptable and noted in relevant planning conditions.

Network Rail is working with construction partners in respect of transport planning for Granhams Road and Addenbrookes Road which is being developed although not currently available for distribution, we will share this further detail with you as soon as it becomes available.
