Dear Ms Catcheside

You should be aware that the Milton/A34 interchange is already overloaded during rush hour despite being recently upgraded. This matter has been of concern at East Hendred Parish Council meetings in relation to the Milton Esso Warehouse Application, recently withdrawn.

This much delayed Hif1 proposal would add more traffic to the Milton/A34 interchange which has been locked up on a number of occasions. Additional traffic from the new East Wantage housing development (4500 homes) will continue to increase and add to the problem. It is evident that OCC Highways management of the situation is laughable and supine.

Additional is the hypocritical attitudes of County Councillors who propose and support environmental destruction and conurbation construction in open countryside while making divisive decisions in the name of Net Zero.
