THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DIDCOT TOWN HIGHWAYS INFRASTRUCTURE – A4130 IMPROVEMENT (MILTON GATE TO COLLETT ROUNDABOUT), A4197 DIDCOT TO CULHAM LINK ROAD, AND A415 CLIFTON HAMPDEN BYPASS) SIDE ROADS ORDER 2022 ("THE SIDE ROADS ORDER")

Dear Secretary of State

As Trustees of land affected by the Side Roads Order we object to the Order as it affects site plans 1 and 2.

Our objection is based on the grounds that this is totally unnecessary, seeing as the whole HIF1 scheme is being objected to as is the whole Compulsory Purchase Order on which much of it seems to rely; and therefore there is absolutely no point in enforcing a Side Roads Order or indeed attempting to enforce it at this particular stage.

We therefore request you to instruct Oxfordshire County Council and Oxfordshire Highways Authority to withdraw this Order.
