We wish to make the following two objections to this Order.

Appleford BR3: The extinguishment will force riders onto a busy and unsafe road. An off-road diversion, perhaps alongside the railway, is essential.

Culham FP6: The proposed extinguishment forces users onto the road if they wish to continue northwards on FP3. A diversion along the field boundary would be more pleasant, and a hedge would give protection from traffic fumes.
