## Dear Secretary of State

I write to make representations regarding the proposed temporary closure of the bridleway/cycleway at Neville Hill as part of this Network Rail project.

## I note that:

- 1. This section of cycleway forms part of route 66 of the National Cycle Network and is a strategically important route linking Leeds city centre to the industrial estates and settlements to the east of the city.
- 2. No timescale is attached to the proposed closure.
- 3. Sustrans (the organisation behind the National Cycle Network) does not appear to have been consulted regarding the closure.
- 4. No mention is made of alternative signed routes to be employed for the duration of the works.

I therefore request that granting of the order is made subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alternative signed routes, meeting the approval of Sustrans and the Cyclists' Touring Club (Cycling UK), are in place for the duration of the closure.
- 2. That the closure is in place for the shortest time possible, and that this time limit is specified.
