On behalf of the Peak & Northern Footpaths Society, I am withdrawing the Society's holding objection to this Order and replacing it with the following:-

All holding objections to the different aspects of the Order are permanently withdrawn forthwith EXCEPT the following aspects which replace it;

the extinguishment of the Level Crossing ("LC") known as "Garforth Moor LC" which enables definitive footpath No.7 (Garforth) to cross the railway line "at grade", without the provision of adequate compensatory measures;

the extinguishment of the Level Crossing known as "Peckfield LC" which enables public bridleway No. 8 (Micklefield) to cross the railway line "at grade" without the provision of adequate compensatory measures.

The Society's "Statement of Case" for which an extension of the deadline was granted until December 1st, will be sent in within the next few minutes.
